There are over 125 LSAC-released Logical Reasoning questions in all, followed by complete explanations of each stimulus and every corresponding question and answer choice. If you choose to do any or all of these sections under timed conditions, this gives you the opportunity to emulate actual testing conditions, allowing you to apply the full range of your Logical Reasoning strategies while also focusing on your pacing under time pressure.
